

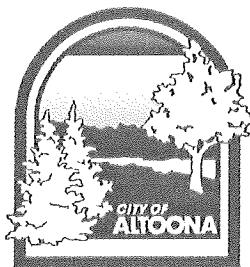

SUBJECT: Summary of June 28, 2010 Council Meeting Items

Provided below for your consideration is a summary of the June 28, 2010 Council Meeting agenda item.

NEW BUSINESS

ITEM 1 - Discuss/consider special exemption for Family Ties to obtain a Picnic License to sell fermented malt beverages at Tenth Street Park (designated consumption & sale area) during a "Taste of Harmony" Festival scheduled for July 4, 2010.

As you may be aware, Chapter 9.23 of Altoona Municipal Code prohibits consumption of Alcoholic beverages within City parks. Family Ties would like to once again hold a festival "Taste of Harmony" in the 10th Street Park and is requesting an exemption from this provision in order to obtain a Picnic License to sell fermented malt beverages at Tenth Street Park during their festival on July 4, 2010. You will note, Family Ties intends to partner with the local VFW, who the license would be issued to.

Therefore, if Council approves waiver of the alcohol ordinance, staff recommends the following conditions apply:

1. Alcohol sales, if approved, will be served and consumed in a designated fenced area, and the license may only be issued to a licensed organization. (Family Ties to provide the fencing).
2. Family Ties will be responsible for picking up and removing all garbage related to the event.
3. Family Ties will be responsible for cleaning the bathrooms at the 10th Street Recreation Center.
4. No music will be allowed at the event after 10 p.m.
5. Family Ties, or their partner, is required to provide liability insurance.

Suggested Motion: I move approval of a special exemption for Family Ties to obtain a Picnic License at Tenth Street Park during their festival on July 4, 2010 with the conditions noted above.
