

**CITY OF ALTOONA, WI**  
**SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES**  
**June 28, 2010**

**(I) Call Meeting to Order**

Mayor William Spangler called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. held in the Council Chambers at Altoona City Hall.

**(II) Pledge of Allegiance**

Mayor Spangler led the Common Council and others in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance.

**(III) Roll Call**

City Administrator Michael Golat called the roll. Council Persons Dale Stuber, Red Hanks, Thomas Meyer, and Ray Henning were present. Also present: City Administrator Mike Golat.

Excused absent: Council Persons Colleen Weber and Brendan Pratt.

**(IV) Citizen Participation Period**

There being no citizen participation, motion by Henning/Meyer to close Citizen Participation Period.

**(V) New Business**

**(1) Consider special exemption for Family Ties to obtain a Picnic License to sell fermented malt beverages at Tenth Street Park (designated consumption & sale area) during a "Taste of Harmony" Festival scheduled for July 4.**

City Administrator Golat explained that Family Ties would like to once again hold a festival "Taste of Harmony" in the 10<sup>th</sup> Street Park and is requesting an exemption from this provision in order to obtain a Picnic License to sell fermented malt beverages at Tenth Street Park during their festival on July 4, 2010. Golat said Family Ties intends to partner with the local VFW, who the license would be issued to. Golat also noted that the following conditions apply:

1. Alcohol sales, if approved, will be served and consumed in a designated fenced area, and the license may only be issued to a licensed organization. (Family Ties to provide the fencing).
2. Family Ties will be responsible for picking up and removing all garbage related to the event.
3. Family Ties will be responsible for cleaning the bathrooms at the 10<sup>th</sup> Street Recreation Center.
4. No music will be allowed at the event after 10 p.m.
5. Family Ties, or their partner, is required to provide liability insurance.

Motion by Henning/Hanks to approve a special exemption for Family Ties to obtain a Picnic License at Tenth Street Park during their festival on July 4, 2010 with the conditions noted above. **Motion carried.**
