

SUMMER UPDATE

July 1, 2020

The pandemic requires us to follow the [Eau Claire City/County Health Department](#) recommendations and CDC guidelines which has impacted our ability to provide summer programs as scheduled. There are many concerns we have worked through in hopes of providing recreation activities for youth and adults this summer. However, recently our community has been elevated to “high risk” in the midst of the COVID pandemic.

Therefore, ALL City of Altoona Parks and Recreation Summer Programs have been cancelled. We simply do not have the resources available to offer these programs at this time to ensure physical distancing can be managed safely. This includes all youth and adult programs and leagues, with the exception of 3rd-6th grade Flag Football.

3rd-6th grade flag football registration will remain open. Please know there is a good chance the program start date will be delayed or cancelled.

Pavilions will remain available to reserve online. Renters must be able to follow CDC guidelines, [Eau Claire City/County Health Orders](#) and physical distancing requirements.

Refunds will be automatically issued and refund checks will be mailed for all cancelled programs. The high volume of refunds will take time to process so please allow extra time for this.
