## TOP REASONS TO LICENSE YOUR DOG

- 🐾 Easy identification is a lost dog's ticket home.
- 🐾 It lets law enforcement know your animal is up to date on its rabies vaccine.
- 🐾 State law and city ordinance requires dogs be licensed.

## THINGS TO KNOW

- ✓ The State requires all dogs, 5 months and older, to be licensed every year & to have current rabies vaccine.
- ✓ **Chapter 6.08 of the Altoona Municipal Code limits a household or place of business to two (2) dogs and three (3) cats.**
- ✓ A dog or cat must be on a leash no longer than six feet (6') in length on a public sidewalk, street, or park.
- ✓ No cat, dog, or domesticated animal is to run at large within the city >> must be leashed.

## HOW TO APPLY | 2024 Dog License Application will be available 12/01/2023

1. **COMPLETE** an application
2. **PROVIDE PROOF OF CURRENT RABIES VACCINATION** State law requires that your pet have a current rabies vaccination. **We need to see documentation from the veterinarian showing the dates the vaccination was given and expiration, manufacturer name and serial number.** Rabies tag is not sufficient proof.
3. **PAYMENT** Please make checks payable to *City of Altoona*
4. **SUBMIT** Application, proof of rabies and payment to *City of Altoona, 1303 Lynn Ave, Altoona, WI 54720*
