Re: Single-Hauler Garbage Collection

The Altoona City Council has recently discussed whether a single-hauler residential garbage collection contract would be a benefit to the citizens of Altoona. The Council intends to discuss this further during a virtual workshop at 5 p.m. on Thursday, February 11th. The City Council had previously considered this topic in 2014 and chose at that time not to proceed.

Currently, the City has six licensed haulers in an open competition environment, three of which offer residential service. Each resident can choose their collector and contract directly with them.

Reasons to consider implementing a single-hauler policy include:

1. Potential reduction of truck traffic impacts on local streets
2. Reduction in vehicle emissions
3. Improved neighborhood aesthetics
4. Reduction of noise
5. Improved safety
6. Potential savings for some residents

Potential drawbacks may include:

1. Elimination of choice for residents
2. Impact on existing garbage collection businesses
3. Change in service preferences (curbside vs. garage collection point, size of container, day of the week, etc.)
4. Additional administrative efforts required of City staff
5. May result in an increased cost for some customers
