GENERAL PROVISIONS AND CONDITIONS OF ISSUANCE

Pursuant to City Code of Ordinances §13.38, this permit is granted to allow the use of a private well as described herein. The following standard provisions and any included special provisions shall govern:

1. The well and pump installation meet or are upgraded to meet the requirements of Ch. NR 812.42 Wis. Admin. Code;
2. The well construction and pump installation have a history of producing bacteriologically safe water as evidenced by one sampling taken prior to the issuance of each permit and each renewal thereof. In areas where the DNR has determined that groundwater aquifers are contaminated with substances other than bacteria, additional chemical tests may be required to establish the safety of the water. Laboratory analysis by a certified laboratory shall be completed every year and submitted to the City. No exception to this condition may be made for unsafe wells, unless the DNR and the City of Altoona Director of Public Works or his/her designee approve, in writing, the continued use of the well;
3. There are no cross-connections between the private well, pump installation and distribution pipes and the municipal water system; and
4. The proposed use of the private well and pump installation can be justified as being necessary in addition to water provided by the water utility.
5. The well water shall not discharge into a drain leading directly or indirectly into the Altoona sanitary sewerage system, unless properly authorized and permitted by the City.
6. The well shall have a functioning pumping system.
7. A permit fee as well as a renewal fee shall be charged, with such a charge to be determined by the City of Altoona's abbreviated fee schedule found in Chapter 3.08 of the City of Altoona Code.
